Dear Worth Park District Residents, Families and Friends:

Beginning on Monday, October 7, the mobilization will begin for the Terrace Centre roof project. This is a project that has been long overdue and is much needed to protect a very valuable resource in the community and, of course, the many children, adults and families who use it. Weather permitting the project should last 30-35 workdays, with the goal of being completed before cold weather arrives.

Park District operations will continue as normal throughout the project. The project will begin with Areas A and A-1 being completed first and then Areas B and C (see map). Areas A and A-1 will be a complete tear off project and B and C will be a recovery.

Throughout the project, the roofing contractor will have staging areas around the building so that they can access the roof safely. The south parking lot will be affected the most as the parking areas along the building will not be available during the project with the exception of one handicapped space. There will remain plenty of spaces for patrons to park on the Altman side of the south parking lot, down 115th Street and behind the Terrace Centre. The project will not affect any traffic on Beloit Avenue for RAS and Preschool drop-offs and pickups.

The Park District along with the contractor is committed to having this project be as safe and efficient as possible. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated. If you have any questions regarding, do not hesitate to contact me.
